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### Post 16 Results at Imberhorne

Imberhorne's Sixth Form students celebrated today as they received their A level results.

148 students were entered for over 400 Advanced level courses this year with more than half of the entries leading to a B grade or better over a range of academic and vocational subjects. Around 80% of entries led to grades A\*-C and the overall pass rate was virtually 100%.

This year saw the introduction of the new A\* grade and 17 students achieved at least one A\* including two students in Y12 who completed their Maths A level a year early. Two students achieved a clean sweep of A\* grades in all their subjects.

Y12 students also receive their AS results today and these students have achieved record results for the school at the half-way stage of their sixth form career.
