Post 16 Results at Imberhorne

Imberhorne's Sixth Form students celebrated today as they received their A level results.

There were more than 400 entries at Advanced Level in a range of academic and applied courses this year. The GCE 'A' Level pass rate was 99% and more than half of these were at grade A or B.

Ten students achieved three or more A grades. Many students followed a range of Advanced Vocational courses as part of their curriculum with an impressive number of top grades.

Particularly successful subjects include: Mathematics, English Literature, Economics, Psychology, Drama, Sociology and Media Studies. Performing Arts, Music Technology and Travel & Tourism were particularly successful vocational subjects.

Whilst the percentage of higher grades is outstanding what matters most is whether each individual student fulfilled his or her potential.
