Subject: Citizenship Yr 7 (2)	Project title: 'Global Citizenship'
<p>Some people use the term 'Minority World' to mean developed or 'First World' countries. The term 'Majority World' can be used to mean developing or 'Third World' countries.</p> <p>Project task: Make a collage of images which shows how Britain is a country in the Minority World; don't forget to label the images.</p> <p>Do you think there are any ways Britain could be described as a Majority World country? <p>You should:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • THINK about the terms 'Minority World' and 'Majority World' and decide what they mean to you. • THINK about what makes Britain a Minority World country. • ARRANGE your pictures neatly and label them. 	<p>You could:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • EXPLAIN <u>exactly</u> what you think the difference between 'Minority World' and 'Majority World' means to you. • DECIDE whether you think the terms 'Majority World' and 'Minority World' are better than 'developing' or 'developed' countries.

Learning Levels	
LL5	In addition to LL4 I have explained why I think the terms 'Minority World' and 'Majority World' can be helpful.
LL4	In addition to LL3 I have added a <u>definition</u> of what I believe 'Majority World' and 'Minority World' world means.
