

Design and Technology ILP. Year 9, 1st half of the Autumn term.

Your chance to be a part of something great: We intend to create a large “Design Timeline” display in the foyer of the Technology block.

In your last Technology lesson of this half term you will need to bring the results of your ILP, be prepared to **explain** what you have done and add them to the timeline display.

The idea is to cover the period from the industrial revolution (c.1760) through to the present and we hope that you will include some ideas for the future in your ILP (you are the ones who will shape it after all!) If you want to go earlier than that, it’s fine too.

Below are some ideas for what you could research in each of the Technology areas, these are only suggestions and you should tailor your choice to suit your interests.

Resistant Materials	Any products (e.g. chairs, kettles, furniture, etc.), architecture and the built environment, designers.
Graphic Products	Posters, packaging, advertising, designers. Their impact on society, moral and social issues.
Food	War time rationing, buying food, farming and food production.
Textiles	Fashion, materials, designers, machinery.
Systems and Control	Technological innovations, steam, radio, music, engines, computers.

Remember, these will go on a wall display, so **large pieces of text are not suitable**, please give details, evaluations, etc. but you must be concise, keep to the point.

Feel free to make models but these will need to be photographed, any pictures or information must be kept to a maximum size of **A5 paper** (210x150mm) choose, clear pictures that aren’t pixellated.

So, how well did you do?

1. Some pictures collected or model made, dates and/or designers included.
2. As above plus annotation and evaluation.
3. As above with an understanding of the impact of designs clearly shown or explained.
