Dear Parent(s)/Guardian(s),

I would like to promote the 'Imber200 Club' which is a fundraising 'lotto' organised monthly by our Governing body. The scheme currently has approximately 120 members who all pay **only £2 per month** as a standing order from their bank accounts. £1 of each contribution goes into a monthly cash prize draw and the other £1 is saved and put towards the many good causes which the Governing body helps to fund; such as sports kits, equipment for extra-curricular activities, projectors on both sites etc... There is a very thorough explanation of the scheme below. I would be delighted to receive your Standing Order Mandate form, addressed to me in an envelope marked '**Mr C Keating**'. This can be handed in to reception on either site and posted to the school for my attention.

- Imber 200 is a source of funding for the school operated by the Imberhorne School Governing Body. that benefits all the members of our school community
- Imber200 is registered with the Charity Commission, registration number 271227 (Imberlink)
- It is a game of chance that **will** result in financial gain for Imberhorne School and **may** result in financial gain for the three lucky number holders each month
- The draw shall be run in accordance with Imber200's Mid Sussex District Council (MSDC) licence, at least 51% of the annual income raised shall be returned in the form of cash prizes, hereafter to be known as "the pot"
- From "the pot" there will be three numbers drawn which will be the prizes for that month.
- The prize money from "the pot" will be allocated proportionately as follows;
 - 1st prize - to be 60% of the pot.
 - 2nd prize - to be 25% of the pot.
 - 3rd prize - to be 15% of the pot.

Prizes will be rounded up to the nearest whole pound

- The draw will take place once a month.
- The draw shall be made by a non-participating member of Imber 200 and witnessed by at least 3 other independent persons.

- The current number of active members of Imber 200 will be published alongside the winning numbers every month.
- If you have won you will be informed by letter and a cheque will be posted to the address that you nominated on Imber200 Form 202, membership details
- The names of the winners will be posted on the notice board in the entrance hall at Lower School, Windmill Lane, and in the next issue of Contact.
- The draw shall require the participation of a minimum of 75 members
- Each participating member must have completed and signed a standing order mandate Imber200 form for £2 per calendar month and a membership details Imber200 form 202
- Each participating member shall be given an individual draw number
- There is no limit to the number of numbers that can be purchased. Individuals or families may hold more than one membership number
- To participate members shall be at least 18 years of age and hold a bank account with a recognised bank or building society that a standing order can be set up against
- Every £2 pledge buys you one membership number which will be allocated and entered in the draw each month
- Each for £2 in favour of the Imber200 account to be collected on the first Tuesday of each month
- The more members that join Imber200, the better our fund raising potential for the school community
- We actively encourage and welcome all members of our school community and their families and friends to join Imber 200
- If the details you supply on the standing order mandate, Imber200 form 201 or membership details Imber200 form 202 change, it is your responsibility to notify the Imber200 operating team
- Entry into the draw is delayed by one calendar month, in lieu. This allows for your forms to be processed at the commencement of your membership of Imber200 and for one month's entry into the draw after we receive notice in writing that you wish to cease membership of Imber200
- Imber200 shall produce accounts annually which shall be audited by the school's auditors at the end of each financial year
