As part of the A2 Travel and Tourism course the students have organised a trip to Thorpe Park as part of their portfolio. Due to limited spaces, this trip will only be offered to selected Leisure and Tourism, Travel and Tourism and Business students where the experience of the trip can benefit their current studies. The trip will be offered on a first come, first served basis and, if spaces are not filled by the deadline, then other students will be asked.

The purpose of the visit is for students to investigate Visitor Attractions and Customer Service, which will form a large part of their course. They will receive an educational talk from Thorpe Park staff and the information that is gathered by the students will be used for their future coursework.

The trip will take place on **Friday 7th October**. Students need to arrive at Imberhorne Lane by **8.40am** as the coach will leave promptly at 9.00am. The return coach will be leaving Thorpe Park at 4.00pm, we aim to be back to Imberhorne School for approximately **6.00pm**.

The total cost of the visit will be **£23.00**, this will include the entry fee to Thorpe Park, the coach journey, insurance and the educational talk. All students are asked to bring a packed lunch or money to buy lunch in the park. Photographs of students on this trip may be used for display and publicity.
