Dear Parents

As part of your son/daughter's experiences in Year 10, he/she will be participating in the school's Community Action Programme which runs over **three weeks in October 2011**. Each student will spend **two days, during one of those weeks** undertaking a variety of tasks, the aim being to experience and participate in their local community. Placements cover a range of opportunities from Nursery and Primary Schools, Charity shops, Nursing homes and work with the Disabled. Students could also undertake placements by helping family, friends and neighbours.

If you know of a relative, friend, or neighbour who would benefit from the services of a young person with tasks such as gardening, cleaning, and the shopping etc then please could you provide me with the details on the form which your son/daughter has been given. Alternatively you will find a copy of the form on the school website under Community Action 2011.

If there is no suitable community placement with family, friends, or neighbours then your son/daughter should fill in their requirements on their **Community Action Placement form**. I will aim to find a suitable placement for them. The placements arranged are with all of the local primary schools in East Grinstead, Copthorne, Crawley Down, Turners Hill and West Hoathly together with many of the local nurseries in these locations. **Please do not contact these placements as this has led to confusion in the past.**

It is the intention to have the majority of students placed by the third week of term next year. If you have any queries then please contact me at School. Your son/daughter will already have been briefed about the project during assembly and will be spending some time with form tutors filling in their forms.
