Dear Parents and Carers

I wish the students and staff a well-deserved break over half term. Whilst there are many restrictions on our travels at the moment I am sure some families will be using this time to get away, if so I hope you have an enjoyable break. We recognise there is a great deal of tiredness in the school, everyone needs to recharge their batteries.

Looking ahead to next half term we have been planning in more detail, the action we will take if we have to send a number of students home to isolate (e.g. due to an identified positive infection).

If isolating, we expect students to follow planned lessons in Google Classroom, information about this has been shared previously. I would also like to flag up a few events in our calendar for November. On Thursday 12th November we are holding a virtual Sixth Form Open Evening. School will finish slightly earlier on this day, as already planned, at 2.30pm. This early finish enables staff to prepare for a number of video conferences with Year 11 students, and their parents, along with any external candidates who wish to join us. We are very proud of our Sixth Form, the results achieved over the last two years mean that we are now one of the best performing Sixth Form schools in the whole of West Sussex and certainly, the top performing Sixth Form school in the middle and north of the County. This is down to really experienced and effective subject specialists, working with an experienced and effective pastoral team. We know how to get the best from our students.

We also have our third inset (staff training) day of the year on Monday 30th November. Students are not expected in school on this date.









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We have been conducting increasing numbers of video presentations in recent weeks. We know from the companies we work with that this is being replicated everywhere. The virtual world is dominating everything at the moment. Our latest video shows some new Year 7 students completing a virtual tour of the Windmill Lane site. I am so impressed with their confidence, seven weeks since they started at the school they will happily show prospective parents what our school looks like and feels like.
