Governors Priorities 2022.23



In order of precedence, our priorities are to ensure that:

1. Supporting the new head teacher

2. Statutory requirements are met

3. Students **learn effectively**, so that academic progress from Sept 2022 is as high as possible for all students

4. DfE, WSCC (and similar) guidelines are followed, unless there's compelling reason not to.

5. The well-being and welfare of pupils and staff is supported strongly

6. Physical **attendance** in school is as high as possible, ensuring that students maximise their time in lessons. Where pupils can't attend, participation in remote learning is as high as possible

7. The activities that were interrupted in last year's **School Development Plan** are evaluated and continue where appropriate

8. Governance improves, specifically "governors hold school leaders to account more effectively" (Ofsted)

9. All reasonable measures are taken to **avoid a financial deficit** (specifically, this and next financial year.
