## Year 9 Consultation Evening - Thursday 23rd January 3.30pm to 7.30pm

I would like to wish you all a Happy New Year, and I hope you had a restful break! I have pleasure in inviting you to the Year 9 Consultation Evening on Thursday 23<sup>rd</sup> January. In line with school policy, assemblies will be cancelled, allowing the school day to finish at 2.30pm. Bus companies have been notified of these changes.

Appointments can be made using our easy to use, online appointment booking system which allows you to book your own appointment times with your son's/daughter's teachers. You will then receive an email confirming your appointment times to bring with you on the evening.

Given the popularity of some subjects at consultation evenings, we would encourage you to only book appointments with teachers of subjects that your son/daughter will be carrying forward into Key Stage 4. Obviously if there are any particular issues that you need to discuss with other subjects, then please do feel free to book an appointment with them also.

Representatives from Business Studies, Textiles and Health & Social Care will also be present if you wish to speak with them regarding these subjects as an option at KS4. These subjects will be here on a dropin basis, so there is no need to book an appointment with them.

The online appointment system will go live at **9.00am on Saturday 11<sup>th</sup> January and will close at 9.00am on Thursday 23<sup>rd</sup> January**. If you wish to check your login details prior to this time, the system can currently be accessed, but you will be unable to make appointments until it goes live. To book your appointments, please visit our school website where you can access and log in to the booking system found under "Parents>Online Services". Log in using your son's/daughter's 'legal' first name and surname that matches our records, together with their date of birth. A short guide can be found on the attached sheet. This guide is also available on our website, together with answers to some frequently asked questions.

Each appointment will be for a maximum of 5 minutes. The online system will automatically ensure you have a 5-minute gap between each appointment to allow you to move rooms. If you wish to have a longer discussion, please arrange a separate meeting with the individual teacher for a later date.
