Instrumental and Singing Lessons at School

Guitar lessons last for 30 minutes and are taught in solo or pairs lessons. Piano and Singing lessons are available as 20 or 30-minute solo lessons only.

Information and Conditions

Please note that minimum notice of a half term is required to terminate lessons.

All lessons are rotated throughout the term so that students do not miss the same school lesson too often.

For students learning from the start of the Autumn Term, the standard course of teaching is 33 lessons in a full school year unless stated otherwise. For students starting later in the school year, the charge will be reduced pro-rata according to the number of lessons remaining.

Maximum group size is two students. Piano lessons are only available on a solo basis.

If a student misses a lesson, it is at the teacher's discretion as to whether the lesson can be made up. This may be dependent on adequate time being available in the term. Where possible please make the teacher aware of any planned absences, such as school trips and exams, at least a week beforehand. Please contact the teacher directly if a student is sick.

The cost of lessons is detailed on the reply slip and is subject to review each year.

Please note that cheques are to be made payable to the teacher directly, not to the school. The arrangement for lessons is between the parent and the teacher and as such any correspondence should be directly between the parent and teacher where possible, not through the school.

The teacher reserves the right to discontinue the lessons, with prior consultation with parents, if they feel that the student is not progressing or has shown a significant lack of interest.

Lessons cannot commence until full payment has been received.
