Year 11

Simple everyday topics such as Introducing yourself, describing yourself and family, free time & leisure activities, adverbs of frequency describing where you live.

Holidays and travel, food and restaurant, school, time, food, body parts, illness and injury, at the doctors, healthy living, preparation for LGD (directions/ market)

Revision of self, family, descriptions. Intro to describing relationships, TV & cinema, invitations to go out, music, reading, technology, food, mealtimes, shops, restaurant, festivals & traditions, talking about a past event, sports events.

Talking about where you live, describing different locations and climates, clothes, describing somewhere in the past, directions, future plans, types of accommodation, ideal house, weather, holidays, transport, hotels, Environment, ethical issues, volunteering.

School, ideal school, school in France, future study and employment plans, types of jobs, job preferences, part time jobs/ pocket money, work experience, future life plans

Indefinite & definite articles, adjectival agreements, present tense, negatives, possessive adjectives, imperative form, pouvoir+ infinitive, je voudrais, partitive article, il y a.

Revision : Present tense, je voudrais, Questions words, il y a
New grammar: Near future tense, perfect tense, Forming questions, reflexive verbs, polite 'vous' form, *il faut* + infinitive, using 3 tenses.

Comparisons, the Imperfect Tense, relative pronoun 'qui', using 'depuis', complex opinion phrases, direct object pronouns, more negatives, using 'on', pronoun 'en', *pour* and *afin de*, venir de, using three tenses.

Revision of negatives, imperfect, *on peut*, question words, il y a
New : Simple future tense, conditional tense, *avant de*, pluperfect tense, modal verbs, superlatives, passive, indirect object pronouns.

Consolidation of different tenses, use of subjunctive, complex sentences, Idioms, 'si' phrases, future plans phrases e.g. *j'espere/ j'ai l'intention de...*, revision of time, depuis, infinitives+ a/ de
