Years 10-13, Geography trip, Morocco, Easter 2019

Building on the success of previous trips to Iceland and Sicily, I am delighted to inform you that this year's Geography trip will be to Morocco. The proposed trip will be for 5 days (with an early morning flight home on the 6th day) and is likely to take place in the 1st week of the Easter holiday. The trip has a variety of curriculum links to support the learning of the students as well as being an amazing cultural experience with the opportunity for students to immerse themselves in incredible landscapes and take part in some unique activities.

The cost of the trip is likely to be around **£850** per person.

The cost will include the following: (Please also see the more detailed preliminary itinerary from our travel company Travel Places, below):

- Private coach hire and driver in Morocco
- Return flights including taxes (Gatwick to Marrakech)
- Tour guide/s
- 3 or 4 nights' accommodation in hotels and 1 night Bivouac at Auberge De Sud Merzouga – half board
- Camel safari
- Olive groves
- Oued Draa and Draa Valley
- Oasis settlement
- Sand dunes of the Sahara
- Tizi-N-Tichka Pass (2260m)
- 1 item of checked luggage
- Insurance

All students would be required to have a valid full passport. If you need to, we recommend you apply to the passport office as soon as possible. In addition to this, your son/daughter will need an EHIC (European Health Insurance Card). Students will not require any injections or immunisations for the trip.
