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Expectations & Achievement

- We are very pleased with our results over the summer
 - Strong attainment and progress at **GCSE**, particularly in core subjects
 - 79% grade 4 and above in English
 - 74% grade 4 and above in Maths
 - 77% grade 4 and above in Science
 - 73% of students of all grades at 4+
 - 84 grade 9's
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- Approximately 66% of the Year 11 students have transferred to our Sixth Form, the rest have embarked upon college courses (FE) or apprenticeships

A Level Performance

Record results for the school

- 58% of all grades were A*- B, 85% of all grades were A*- C with a record 33% at A/A* grades
- Progress from GCSE to A Level puts us in the top 25% of all schools and colleges nationally
- 71% of our cohort have gone to University or have secured a deferred place at University
- 24% have taken up an apprenticeship or gained employment
- Sixth Form is inclusive and prepares students for many different pathways
