UCAS Deadline: Wednesday 31st January 2023



The UCAS application process

What the applicant does...

- Writes a personal statement,
- Completes an online application,
- Pays
 - £22.50 for a single course
 - £27.00 for more than one course (maximum of 5 course choices)

What the school does...

- Supports the personal statement process,
- Provides a reference,
- Predicts applicant A level grades,
- Checks the application and sends it to UCAS.
