Modern Foreign Languages

Languages give you the edge

- GCSE or A Level qualifications in languages open doors for traditional careers but also in digital marketing, social media and sales.

Languages open up the world

 Learning any language can make us more successful working abroad and builds resilience and agility. It provides 'cultural capital'. We're living in the age of the soft skills, so being good listeners and communicators will not only boost your grades but also give you the edge in side hustles, networking and future life.

Languages are a commodity

 It's easy to fall back on outdated excuses like "English is the world language" to get ourselves out of trialling our own abilities. It was recently announced that French will replace English as the official working language of the EU. In this increasingly globalised world, languages have become like currency or stock - the more you speak, the higher your value rises.



Portfolio-Based Courses

GCSE courses are examined at the end of Year 11 – two or three exams test knowledge and understanding across the course.

BTEC / Cambridge National courses (Health & Social Care, Creative Media, Sport BTEC) combine an exam with two units of portfoliobased coursework (worth 60% of the final grade).


Students work on the coursework elements across Years 10 and 11, in lesson-time and homework. Students have to keep up with portfolio deadlines; the course structure does not allow time to catch-up.

Students with low attendance should not choose these courses.

The two NCFE courses are a little more flexibility and can be taken by students with lower attendance.







Students can only choose one PE-based course (GCSE PE, Sport BTEC or Health & Fitness) from the Health and Fitness area.

Students cannot choose both art & photography.

Students studying Italian in Year 9 may choose this as their GCSE Language, if they are recommended by their Italian teacher.

Students can only choose one Technology course.

Support Option & Construction are for recommended students only.





GCSE RE

The core curriculum gives all students 1 hour per fortnight of RE and 3 hours per fortnight of core PE.

Students can choose to follow a GCSE RE course by transferring 1 hour of core PE to RE instead: 1 lesson per week of RE and 1 lesson per week of core PE.



Twilight Courses

After school classes running from 3.10pm (lesson 6).

Triple Science is for students wanting to take separate GCSEs in Biology, Chemistry and Physics. Students will be taught in the same groups for science during the normal school day and in the twilight.

Italian allowing students to study an additional language.

Level 2 Further Maths

These courses require a 2 year commitment & we recommend you only choose one twilight.
