

The PiXL booklets

- The booklets that you can pick up this evening take you through some of the basic things to support with at home and reinforce to your students
 - Cognitive load—trying to reduce the overwhelm as much as you can by simplifying things. Fouring on one thing at a time and reducing any draws in their study space
 - Spaing interleaving and timing—much of this context down to their revision timetable. This is a key item, to work on at home (more on the next slide)
 - Hippedleaning—encoraging independent leaning Where constudents find note information about a topic, widen their own knowledge on it and take questions to their teacher
 - Chrking-beskingdown information and making links but making it bite sized

- One way of helping them do this is by testing them on what they have revised . .
- 'I amoging to test you on that in 20 minutes'.'
- Qick Q&A—howmuch can they recall from their rates? If they nortion 8/10 things from the page in the revision gick/minchap/flash cards—they need to go and learn it again!






