Dear Students, Parents and Carers

As you are only too aware there has been much controversy surrounding the grade awarding process since the publication of A level (and equivalent) grades last week.

The government announced late yesterday afternoon that they are now authorising the awarding of centre assessed grades, this means that grades will be reissued to students. We believe this is the fairest approach, recognising that within the headline figures there were a number of inconsistencies that did not reflect the capability of individuals. The much-discussed algorithms affected different subjects in different ways.

As soon as the reissued grades are made available to us we will publish them in Edulink, our students' and parents' portal, I will write again to advise you of the availability of the reissued grades in Edulink. The reissued grades will be the school centre assessed grades along with any grades that were moved up by the standardisation process. If any students wish to know their centre assessed grades in advance of this (to confirm university places or other offers) we will happily share this information.
